Our rent has increased substantially this year (per the original terms of our lease). This has put a squeeze on funds, making it necessary to get creative!

A new fundraiser is starting. We are expecting some costly repair bills to crop up in the near future. One of these is evaporator replacement in the walk-in cooler. estimated to cost more than \$1800. We will also be replacing a fire suppression tank for the kitchen hood, which is mandatory to bring us up to current code. This will be somewhere in the area of \$400. These are anticipated expenses, but we also need to plan for those unexpected repairs.
