




Greetings Members,

Soon, you will be receiving your bill for your annual dues to the Elks club. Make sure to check off the box for ENF contribution. Your donation to the ENF is 100% tax deductible.

Once a lodge member reaches \$100.00 in cumulative ENF donations, that member name is engraved on a metal tag, and mounted on the \$100 ENF board. Once a lodge member surpasses \$250 in cumulative donations to the ENF, his or her name tag moves up to the "Big" board. The "Big" board categories are \$250, \$500, \$1,000, \$2,000, \$5,000, and \$10,000. In addition, the Elks will send you an unique pin for every donation level that you achieve.

We need to make our per capita per member goal of \$1,431. By doing this, we become eligible for at least a \$2,000 gratitude grant from the ENF for our lodge to give to worthy causes.
