

ENF Update




On Sunday, January 12th, at the quarterly state Elks meeting, Bill Roy of Manchester lodge 146 was honored for achieving the \$5,000 level of giving to the Elks National Foundation. Exalted Ruler Marlene Lein and Elks

National Foundation chairman Paul Byrne were there to present Bill with a certificate of achievement for accomplishing

this feat.

How significant an achievement is this? Of all the THOUSANDS of people that have been Elks in the state of New Hampshire, only 10 individuals have met or exceeded this level of giving. On a national level, of all the MILLIONS of people that have ever been Elks in the United States, only 880 individuals have met or exceeded this level of giving.




Legions Sweeney Post in Manchester, and has also dedicated a lot of volunteer time to the causes of the American Legion.
