Greeting Members,

The Elks fiscal year ended April 1st, and the Elks National Foundation results are in. Manchester lodge #146 contributed \$1600.00 to the ENF for member per capita

of \$5.22. Salem/Derry lodge was tops in the state with a member per capita of \$17.02. On the national level, Guy-mon, OK. lodge #1885, was tops in the nation with a member per capita of \$147.30.

I want to reiterate to all members that it is important for us to make the Elks national per capita of \$4.50 per member. By not making the per capita goal, our lodge is NOT ALLOWED to apply for most grant money.

What was the "ECONOMIC RETURN " from the ENF through Manchester lodge #146 last year?

43 children at Summer camp:	\$18,000
College scholarships:	\$7,000
Gratitude Grant (2 recipients):	\$2,000
Beacon Grant (West High Sp.Ed):	\$1,000

\$28,000

For \$1,600 dollars invested, we got an " economic return " of \$28,000, for an ROI (return on investment) of 1,750%. I dare say, you will not find too many non-profit charitable organizations that can return a bang for your buck like the Elks National Foundation.

Lastly, I would like to thank everyone who donated this past year, and all who helped during the yard sale and fundraiser.

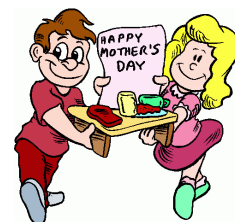
