ARTICLE II-ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

The Governing Body of the Lodge as designated in Article IX can grant Associate Membership to Members in good standing in other Lodges solely for the use of the Lodge's social facilities upon such terms as it may prescribe.

The Governing Body of the Lodge as designated in Article IX can grant Associate Membership to Members in good standing in other Lodges solely for the use of the Lodge's social facilities *for a fee of \$25. per annum based on the Elk year and* upon such terms as it may prescribe.

ARTICLE IV: MEETINGS

Section 1. The regular meeting of this Lodge shall be held on the first and third Wednesday evenings in each month Throughout the year, except that in the months of July, August and December, meetings of the Lodge shall be held on the first Wednesday evening of each thereof.

Section 1. The regular meeting of this Lodge shall be held on the first and third Wednesday evenings in each month throughout the year, *except that in the months of July and August, meeting of the Lodge shall be held on the third Wednesday evening of each thereof and in the month of December it will be held on the first Wednesday evening.*

ARTICLE V: ELECTIVE OFFICERS AND DUTIES OF THE TILER

For the faithful performance of his duties he shall receive as compensation for his services the sum of \$65.00 per annum, payable annually.

For the faithful performance of his duties he shall receive as compensation for his services the sum of **\$75.00** per annum, payable annually.

ARTICLE VIII: COMMITTEES

Section 1

- b. A Membership Committee*
- c. A Community Activities Committee*
- d. A lodge Activities Committee*
- e. A Youth Activities Committee*
- f. An Elks National Foundation Committee*

Add in:

(b) An Activities Committee, consisting of no fewer than three members, which shall be charged with the following:

- 1. Implement the drug awareness program, the Hoop Shoot program, and the public relations program of the Lodge, the State Association, and the Grand Lodge.*
- 2. Supervise all matters pertaining to the Lodge activities of civic, social, and community interest, including one program solely identified as Elks-sponsored within the jurisdiction of the lodge, and develop community projects that emphasize the charitable works of the Order.*
- 3. Prepare, supervise, and conduct programs for the youth of the community, and implement all youth programs of the Lodge, the State Association and the Grand lodge.*

Note: See Sec. 13.020 and 13.021, Statutes of the Order.

(c) A Fraternal Committee, consisting of no fewer than three members, which shall be charged with the following:

1. *Implement the patriotic activities planned by the Grand Lodge and cooperate with other local organizations in fostering patriotic community endeavors.*
2. *Prepare and carry out all arrangements for Flag Day services as required by the provisions of Section 2.030.*
3. *Prepare, supervise and conduct a planned program for indoctrination of candidates and their families prior to initiation in order that all candidates and their families may become fully informed as to the good works of the Order of Elks*
4. *Investigate the character of all applicants for membership and reinstatement, personally interview all applicants, verify the statements in their application, and report at the next regular meeting of the Lodge.*
5. *Secure applications for membership in the Order, investigate and report on all delinquencies in Lodge dues, encourage delinquent Members to pay their dues and avoid being dropped from the rolls of the Lodge, and promote the reinstatement of lapsed Members. The committee shall regularly report to the Lodge on membership.*
6. *Implement the Lodge activities program of the Lodge, its State Association, and the Grand Lodge.*
7. *Arrange for the observance of Elks Memorial Day as required by the provisions of Section 2.020.*
8. *Publicize the Elks National Foundation, promote its programs, activities, and charities, encourage and solicit contributions, and recognize all gifts made to the Foundation*
9. *Implement the programs of the Elks National Veterans Service Commission within the Lodge in furtherance of service to veterans, assist when called upon by the Armed Forces of the United States, respond to any call for aid and cooperation requested by the government in any emergency, and be available to assist in the event of disaster in any area of the United States.*

NOTE: See Sec. 13.020 and 13.022, Statutes of the Order

ARTICLE X: FEES AND DUES

Sec. 2

The regular Lodge dues shall be \$65.00 per year.

In addition to the amounts set forth in the first paragraph of this section, each Life Member shall pay \$15. towards Lodge administration expense.

The regular Lodge dues shall be **\$55.00** per year.

In addition to the amounts set forth in the first paragraph of this section, each Life Member shall pay **\$10.** towards Lodge administration expense.

(NOTE: Fees for membership consist of the Lodge dues as stated above as well as the fees associated with Grand Lodge per capita fee, Grand Lodge per capita insurance assessment, and State Association dues, this will result in the actual annual fee of \$73.50 for general membership and \$28.50 for life membership.)
