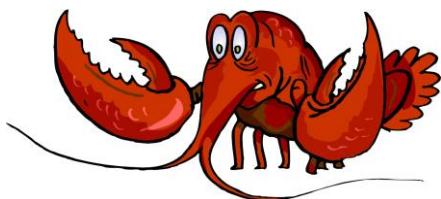
It is that kind of initiative that I am honored to give the Elk of the Month for July to Amy Burke.
