<u>Departure time</u> from the Nashua Elks Lodge is 5:30 PM. Please join us.



Friends, family and community members pledged money for each free throw Lauren or Mitchell sank in their respective Hoop Shoot contests. Because of their compassionate hearts and free throw skills, Mitchell raised more than \$8,500 for his friend, and Lauren raised more than \$7,000 for hers. Now that's a trophy!

"As Elks, one of the things we hope to accomplish by funding youth programs like the Hoop Shoot is passing on our values of charity and service to young people," says Director Jim O'Kelley. "At last year's finals, Mitchell and Lauren taught *us* something about both of those values."
