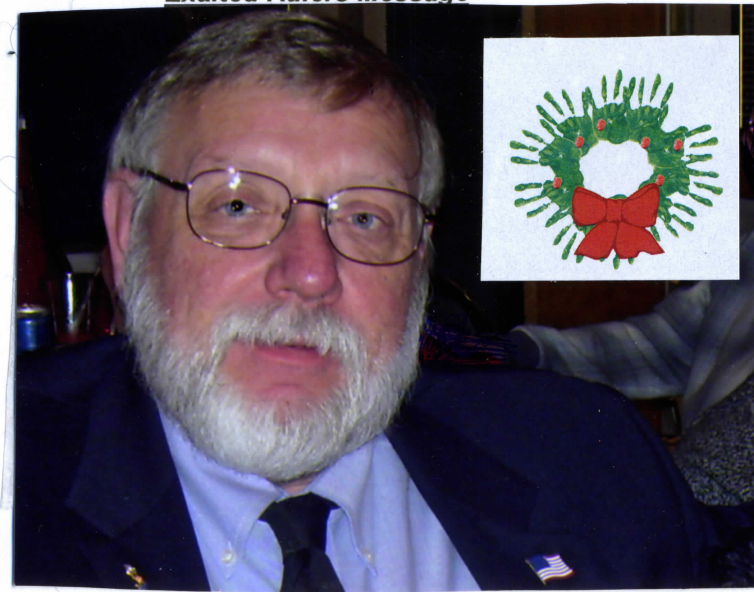


Exalted Rulers Message

Proposed House Rule and By-Law Revisions
that were read at the November 25th, 2013 lodge meeting and will be
Voted on at the December 23rd, 2013 lodge meeting

There will be a vote on the proposed by-law changes and house rule changes at the regular Monday night meeting on December 23rd. The purpose of the special vote is for a general revision, and any other changes can also be considered.

Proposed House Rule Changes

Present House Rule #1: The grill and lounge will be closed during Lodge meetings and mandatory rituals. Anyone not attending the meeting or ritual must leave the Lodge. Amended House Rule #1 will now read: The grill and lounge will be closed during Lodge meetings and mandatory rituals. **Members** not attending the meeting or ritual must leave the Lodge.

Please Note: The following House Rule change may have already been voted on and passed at a meeting in 2011.

Present House Rule #3: All guests must be signed into the visitor's log upon each visit. A guest living within the jurisdiction of the Lodge will be allowed (3) visits. After the third visit he/she will not be allowed to patronize the grill, lounge or pool room unless he/she has submitted an application with a sponsor and has been approved by the investigating committee. This is with the exception of the sponsor's significant other. When the member leaves, the guests must leave. Revised House Rule #3: **All significant others, friends and guests must be signed into the visitors log upon each visit with the exception of spouses with spouse cards. When the member leaves the significant other, friend or guest must also leave unless re-signed in by another member.**

Present House Rule #9: Members cannot remove any Lodge property without permission of the Chairman of the Board of Trustees. Revised House Rule #9: Members cannot remove any Lodge property without permission of the Chairman of the **Board of Directors.**

Present House Rule #12: The manager, person in charge (PIC), bartenders and members of the Executive Committee shall have full authority to enforce the above house rules. Revised House Rule #12: The manager, person in charge (PIC), bartenders and members of the **Board of Directors** shall have full authority to enforce **all** house rules.

Present House Rule #14: Charges may be brought against anyone violating any of these rules and/or not conducting himself/herself as a good Elk. Any and all complaints regarding these rules must be made in writing, signed and submitted to the Executive Committee for action. Revised House Rule #14: Charges may be brought against anyone violating any of these rules and/or not conducting himself/herself as a good Elk.

Any and all complaints regarding these rules must be made in writing, signed and submitted to the **Board of Directors** for action.

Present House Rule #17: The Executive Committee reserves the right to change any of the above for special events. Revised House Rule #17: The **Board of Directors** reserves the right to change any of the above for special events.

Present House Rule #18: Auxiliary members with a proper identification card have rights of admission and use of the Lodge facilities, subject to State and Local laws. Revised House Rule #18: Auxiliary members with a proper identification card have rights of admission, **rights to purchase goods and services** and use of the Lodge facilities, subject to State and Local laws.

Proposed By-Law Changes

By-Law Article 4 (*Page 4*): MEETINGS, Section 1 presently reads: The regular meetings of this Lodge shall be held on the second and fourth Monday evenings in each month throughout the year, except that in the months of July and August, meetings of the Lodge shall be held on the fourth Monday evening of each thereof. Revised By-Law Article 4: MEETINGS, Section 1 would read: The regular meetings of this Lodge shall be held on the second and fourth Monday evenings in each month throughout the year, except that in the months of July and August, meetings of the Lodge shall be held on the fourth Monday evening of each thereof. **If the date of a regular meeting night coincides with the date of a legal holiday, the meeting would be held on the following Tuesday.**

By-Law Article 10 (*Page 22*): FEES AND DUES, Section 2 paragraph 3 and 4 presently read: The regular Lodge dues shall be \$60.00 per year. In addition to the amounts set forth in the first paragraph of this section, each Life Member shall pay \$6.50 towards Lodge administration expense. Revised By-Law Article 10: FEES AND DUES, Section 2 paragraph 3 and 4 would read: The regular Lodge dues shall be \$60.00 per year **plus the Grand Lodge and State Association assessments.** In addition to the amounts set forth in the first paragraph of this section, each Life Member shall pay \$6.50 towards Lodge administration expense, **plus the Grand Lodge and State Association assessments.**

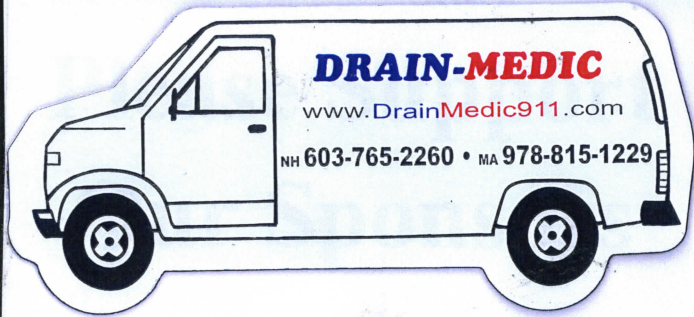

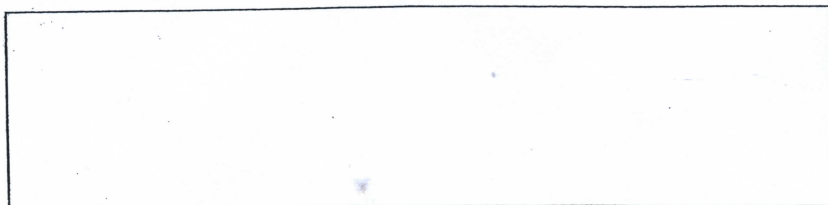
