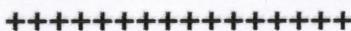
Nomination For Life Membership

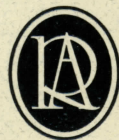

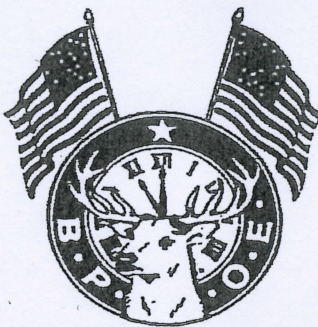

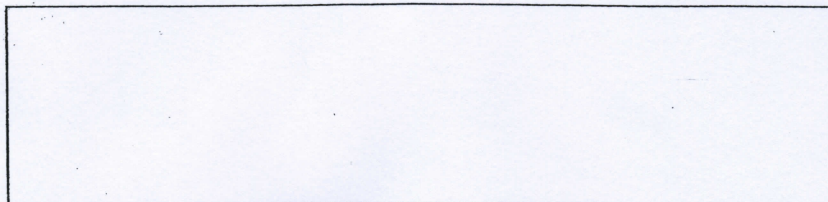
