On the Saturday following each holiday, the flags are picked up, cleaned and stored for the next holiday. The Elks have enlisted many volunteers <u>but still need more</u>.

This program, organized by long time member Roland Caron, who had recruited a vast number of volunteers from church, youth and civic groups, besides Elks and Emblem Club members, to carry out this very worthwhile and touching 'remembrance of deceased veterans'. 


