This year, applications are available ONLY ON LINE: www.elks,org/org/enf/scholars/mvs.clm. for high school seniors that wish to apply for a scholarship award in the Elks National Foundation's annual "Most Valuable Student" contest. Nationally, 500 Four-Year Awards for the 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 Academic years, ranging from \$1,000 to \$12,50000 per year, will be awarded in a nationwide competition to the highest-rated boys and girls in the 2014 competition, totaling \$2,440,000.

Applicants are judged on the core values of the Elks National Foundation: Knowledge Charity, Community and Integrity.
