

AMessage from the Exalted Ruler

Sandy and I just returned from attending the Grand Lodge Convention in New Orleans. Arriving on Thursday, July 10th we spent that evening and most of Friday fighting with the hotel over the State hospitality room. We got it resolved late in the afternoon and were able to open Saturday. Now we had to stock the room with snacks, beer and liquor. Right next door was a number of small convenience stores that sell beer and liquor at a ridiculous cost. Example of prices, I had to get a half gal. of milk the cost was \$4.91. Needless to say we shopped somewhere else. Walmart carries everything even liquor.

Saturday all other hospitality rooms in the hotel were being moved or still fighting with them. We were the only one open, we got swamped. Sunday was opening ceremony, with the parade of flags, in which all the State Presidents carried their State Flag up to the stage. Monday through Thursday there were meetings every morning and open seminars in the afternoons. Monday night was the New England Dinner which cost \$150.00 a person. This was the best that Sandy and I have attended, both the food and entertainment were very enjoyable. Wednesday as State President took all 53 of the NH Delegation out to dinner, a great time was had by all.

Because of this we will now have to start paying property taxes, which we have not had to do since we have been in Gilford. With this we need to come up with more ways to make money for the Lodge. Again tell an officer your ideas. We get the same approx. 10 people that come to meetings other than the officers, 25 to 27 is not that good when our membership is around 600. Remember we are an Elks Lodge with a bar, not a bar with an Elks Lodge.
