

A Message from the Exalted Ruler

Another month has come and gone. We started this past month with initiating 6 new members. The queen of hearts was hit by Erin, winning \$4900. Congratulations Erin. Arnold and his crew did a fabulous job with Mothers Day Brunch, only to be surprised with the arrival of 11 veterans from the Tilton Veterans Home to join us for breakfast. Your officers did a great job performing the Mothers Day Services that afternoon. We had a large number of members attend the state convention. Congratulations to the new state officers. Our own Sandy Shene becoming the state president, Lisa Collins as president elect, Gerry Gravel state treasurer, G. Edward Norway 5 year trustee, and George LaBonte as 5th vice president.

At the convention it was announced that in just over a month in the new year two lodges had met their GER's ENF per capita for the year already. Laconia being the first. It was also stated that we must continue to contribute even though we met our goal. The more we send in the more comes back to help with the Vets, the youth programs and Copper Cannon. By meeting our goals we are now eligible for \$16,000 in lodge grants. Some of these grants just takes us to have a purpose and apply, such as the Gratitude and Beacon Grants, which we have been getting. Others have limited number of applicants that get them. For example the first qualifying 500 applicants can get the Promise Grant to be used on the youth of our community. This grant also requires membership participation, it cannot be just giving out money. The Freedom Grant is a \$2,000 grant to be used for veterans, with only 140 of these being given. The Impact Grant is the largest of all grants at \$10,000. It also demands the most Elks participation. More information is available by contacting our ENF chairperson Sandy Shene or on line at Elks.org. Just think of what we could do to help our community with all this grant money, so please give it lots of thought and talk to one of the officers.


